

2019 ASID Interior Design Tour

General Rules and Designer Responsibilities

1. Selection Criteria

- □ Applicant must be an ASID MN Professional, Allied or Associate Member
- □ Project must be completed in the last three years
- Project must demonstrate code compliance
- □ There must be available parking near the project's site
- Condition of the exterior and interior of the home are expected to be wellmaintained
- □ The location of the home may be a factor
- Overall functionality, creativity, details and material sections will be considered
- □ Overall space, lighting and furnishing plan will be considered
- Overall clarity and presentation of the design/concept statement and project will be considered
- □ Project has a special story, feature, area of interest
- 2. Applicant will submit the following via Dropbox by November 15, 2018:
 - Tour Application
 - □ Photos of project (they do not need to be professional photos for application)
 - Project Description and Materials Checklist
- 3. After acceptance into the tour the Applicant will provide the following via Dropbox by December 20, 2018:
 - Signed Designer Letter of Agreement
 - Signed Homeowner Letter of Agreement
 - □ \$1000 Entry Fee (by check only)
 - □ Certificate/Proof of Insurance
 - □ Copy of Homeowner's Proof of Insurance (provided to designer by homeowner), required only if pets of any kind will be staying on premises during the tour.
 - Map and directions to your entry location
- 4. Applicant or representative from the firm will:
 - □ Attend kit delivery meeting in April 18, 2019
 - □ Help promote the tour via social media and other outlets



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- 5. ASID MN Interior Design Tour committee will provide:
 - □ Coordination and marketing of the tour
 - Welcome sign
 - Directional signage
 - □ Shoe coverings
 - Deposit bag (primed with change for selling tickets)
 - Tickets
 - □ Ticket tracking sheet
 - □ Sponsor materials and more
- 6. Applicant agrees to the following:
 - Allow committee members to preview the project December 3-6, 2018 (the time will be coordinated with the designer), acceptance into the tour will be announced by December 10, 2018
 - Provide additional information as requested my Midwest Home magazine via Dropbox at a later date:
 - Minimum of two professional photographs of each project room represented on the tour, including photographer's information
 - Designer Biography
 - Designer Headshot
 - Company Logo
 - Detailed directions to the home from the nearest highway
 - Number of directional signage needed (arrows)
 - Project questionnaire
 - Floor plan (if available)
 - Before/in-progress photos and videos (if available)
 - Staff the entirety of the tour with representatives from their firm
 - Staff a ticket taker and provide a table and chair for them
 - Display printed materials provided by ASID MN/Midwest Home either in the kitchen or on the table with the ticket taker
 - Block access to the rest of the home as necessary
 - Set up and take down directional signage while adhering to local rules related to signage
 - Provide a basket for used booties
 - □ Return all materials ASID MN office by April 22, 2019
